Dear Commissioner Hanson:

Minnesota Statutes, Section 473.915, provides that the chair of the Metropolitan Council shall give notice to the Legislative Advisory Commission secretary when a Council procurement of over \$125,000,000 is being considered.

Pursuant to that provision, I am hereby notifying you that the Metropolitan Council intends to issue the following procurement on May 28, 2010: Procurement of Civil West Construction - Contract #10P019

The Civil West contract work is located in Minneapolis. The project limits extend generally on 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Washington Avenue, along Washington Avenue across the Washington Avenue Bridge to the Transitway, along the Transitway to University Avenue, and along University Avenue to the border of Hennepin and Ramsey Counties.

The Civil West contract includes structural modifications and deck replacement of the Washington Avenue Bridge, underground public utilities, drainage, street lighting, light rail track, bridge and retaining wall structures, light rail stations, adjustments to areaways (below ground building spaces), underground communications, signal, and traction power ducts, pull boxes, above and below-grade traffic signal facilities, catenary pole foundations, sidewalk, and roadway pavements.

The Civil West contract does not include the light rail train control signaling, communications, overhead catenary system, and traction power systems, which will be included under a separate contract.

The current engineer's estimate is \$135.7 million which includes \$113.1 million construction cost and \$22.6 million in contingency.
